Motion made by Pat Gagas and seconded by Ann Omernik to approve the financial report.

Old Business:

1. Spring Raffle Update---Loose tickets at the entrances are being picked up continuously. There are 27 PCCW member envelopes left in the box. If envelopes are not picked up in the next week, they will be added to the loose tickets for pickup. There were suggestions made to add a pie sale to the raffle drawing. Pies would have to be a project made in the church kitchen. Who would undertake the project, get orders, get ingredients, in only a month? We will seriously think about making pies or desserts with the soup sale.
2. Soup Sale will be held in the Fall, planning for November 13 this will give us more time to plan. We will need quart jars. Betty Ostrowski will hold any donated jars at her house. St Peter's charged \$9.00 a quart, Bevent charges \$5.00 and \$6.00, St Maximillian is \$8.00. We would charge \$6.00 per Quart.
