

**SACRED HEART PARISH OF CATHOLIC WOMEN MEETING**  
**APRIL 12, 2021 AT 6:30PM**

Meeting was called to order at 6:30.

President Dorothy Burant opened the meeting in prayer.

Vice President Deb Adamski was excused.

Reports:

1. Arleen read the meeting minutes from the March 8, 2021 meeting. Motion made to approve the minutes by Germaine Zoromski and seconded by Betty Kowalski.
2. Judy Wroblewski gave the financial report. \$21,394.20 in the working checking account. St Ambrose account is \$42,239.79, \$2047.19 in the Seminarian fund. Accounts have earned \$1239.71 interest in one year at St Ambrose. \$260.96 was paid to TH Stemper Co for altar supplies. Motion made to approve the financial report by Ann Omernik and seconded by Deb Falkavage.
3. Betty Kowalski updated the cookbook balance to \$17,681.39

Old Business:

1. Update on Spring Raffle---So far \$2650 in ticket sales have been deposited and \$890 in raffle sponsorship. There will be 6 extra prizes: James Kezeske donated \$100 in memory of Sylvia Kezeske as prize #4. The Foresters donated \$25 and there are 4 donated \$25 Scrip cards.
2. Pie Sale-- Should this be done at the time of the soup sale? Would we have to bake the pies in the Church Kitchen? Maybe by November we could have a bake sale where donated pies could be sold.
3. Soup Sale---The date is November 13 and selling price will be \$6. The hall is reserved for November 12 and 13. Discussion on first come first serve or preorder sale. Will do preorder sales. Will do preorder for 6 weeks and allow a two-week window for getting supplies. Soups will be chicken noodle, vegetable beef barley, and cheesy potato w/bacon and ham.

New Business:

1. Rose Changes---Kathy Groshek resigned as leader for Rose 7. The new leader will be Betty Ostrowski. Dorothy Gagas resigned as leader of Rose 8 and moved to Rose 15. The new leader will Elaine Check. Dorothy asked if anyone has any ideas on how to reorganize to attract more members. We are struggling with members who have not paid dues in many years. Dorothy contacted the office to see if some of the past dues are still members of the parish. Ideas are to move past dues more than four years to inactive.
2. PCCW minutes ---There have been requests for printed minutes. They will not be inserted in the bulletin but copies will be made available at the elevator entrance and the front entrance.
3. Meeting time change request--It was mentioned to change the meeting time to afternoons at 1 or 2. Objections included time would limit working members, and having to stop home projects in the middle of the day. Another consideration would be meeting after the Sunday morning Mass. Will leave decision open until September.
4. Betty Kowalski volunteered to lead the Rosary for the May meeting.
5. Diaper Drive ---The Annual Diaper Drive (not held in 2020) will start from April 19 through Mother's May 9. We support First Choice Pregnancy Resource Center with the donations. Donations requested

are diapers, wipes, receiving blankets, and new stuffed animals. Donations can be dropped off on the rectory porch, elevator entrance, and back of Church.

6. There will be no Spring Open Assembly at this time.
7. November Steak Night still in question.

Next meeting will be May 10, 2021 at 6:30 beginning with the Rosary outside weather permitting. The short business meeting will be followed by a social.
