

**SACRED HEART PARISH OF CATHOLIC WOMEN MEETING
JANUARY 11, 2021 at 6:00 PM**

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

President Dorothy Burant opened the meeting in prayer.

Vice President Deb Adamski was excused. Besides the remaining officers, six members were in attendance. Lee Falkavage and Mike Burant came to do a presentation.

Reports:

1. Arleen Gross read the meeting minutes from the November 9, 2020 meeting. Arleen read a thank you from Dan Symth. He was given \$500 from the Seminarion Fund. Motion made to approve the minutes by Deb Falkavage and seconded by Betty Kowalski.
2. Judy Wroblewski gave the financial report: \$21,159.05 in the working checking account
Ambrose funds include \$40950.93, Seminary CD \$2019.23, and Cookbook Fund. Judy updated the income and expenses for 2020 Income was \$12,032.06 and expenses were \$8,838.07. Motion made by Ann Omernik and seconded by Deb Falkavage to approve the Financial report.
3. Betty Kowalski updated the Cookbook account balance which is \$17,600.13.
4. KC Request presented by Lee Falkavage and Mike Burant: The KC's will not be doing a February steak night. Lee would like to have fish fries at the Rosholt Legion during Lent. Considering doing sit down dining, carry outs, and bar. PCCW would not be able to help because of Covid. The members that usually work are over 65. Suggestion was made to only do carryouts which the KC's could handle with less help. PCCW might be able to help by providing desserts. KC's will think about these options.

Old Business:

1. The PCCW web page was mentioned in the bulletin.
2. Low Sunday Collection. In 2019 we sent \$275.00. We will send the same. The check will be sent to Carol Kvatek of the Stevens Point Deanery to send on to the DCCW of La Crosse.
3. Vanilla is now stored at the Church. People's Meat Market has our vanilla for sale.
4. A raffle was discussed in November. We were waiting to see what the KC's would do the first weekend in February. We will have a spring raffle with the drawing in the spring after a Sunday Mass. It would be a cash raffle. Arleen will talk to Germaine Zoromski about raffle details.

Not discussed at the meeting in a conversation with Germaine after:

It takes almost three months of work to conduct a productive raffle.

The first thing is to ask for donations through the bulletin, etc.

After you know what your donations are, we can add our \$1000 to the raffle as prizes.

For example, our last raffle at the February 2019 night were:

The parish donations were \$1325.

The donation request time was three weeks. Then the tickets are printed and handed out. We should allow at least 6 weeks for sales before the drawing.
