Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Reports:

1. Arleen Gross read the minutes from the March 9, 2020 meeting minutes.
2. Judy Wroblewski gave the Financial Report which included Masses that were sent for Viola Richter, Jeanette Wiza, Mary Ann Platta, and Elaine Omernik. The checkbook balance is \$21,864.32. She included information on the funds sent to the St Ambrose Fund. The interest rate at the start in March was at 3.05%, now at 2.95%. Funds at St Ambrose include the Seminarian CD, Cookbook Fund, and \$40,000 from the checking account. Judy gets copies of the monthly statements for anyone that would like to review.

Old Business

1. Dessert Discussion – Desserts will be put in the donated pans on the table by the freezer. They will be boxed after the meal is done. The dishes/pans will be washed for the donator to take home. Leftover desserts should go to the family
2. Comforting Prayers – A basket with sayings, cartoons and religious prayer cards will be given to members or any ill parishioners as comforting thoughts.
3. Bake sale for the Sisters will be put on hold.
4. Speaker Pati Karchel will not be here on October 17th. We will try to schedule her for next year.

New Business

1. Guidelines – Social Distancing, Sanitizing the area that is being used, Wearing face masks and no food is allowed.
2. Mass for the 60+ members will be October 10th at 4:00. There are 4 members – Bernadette Glodowski, Lorraine Pionkowski, Emily Ramczyk and Emily Zinda. A letter needs to be sent to these ladies (two weeks prior) inviting them to the Mass. Announcement should be put in the bulletin one week before. Coffee and doughnuts will not be served after Mass in the hall per Father.
3. Fall Open Assembly/Board Meeting - Stevens Point Deanery is checking on this. Should the meetings be combined? Debbie Wolfe will contact me when she has an answer. It will be listed in the bulletin if there is a meeting. Per the Stevens Point Deanery they are requesting that the October 15, 2020 Open Assembly be held. We were thinking that we could have 3 persons per table. Currently there are 21 tables set up. That would be 63 people total. There would have to be pre-registration to attend. There would be no entry fee. No food would be served. There would be no door prizes or raffle.
